Frank C. Cassulo is president, Chevron Pipe Line Company, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Chevron Corporation, a role he assumed in June 2016. CPL also provides technical, commercial, operational and project management support to Chevron’s pipeline projects around the world.

Previously, Frank was deputy managing director, Eurasia Strategic Business Unit in Kazakhstan, where he was responsible for operational excellence, exploration, NOJV operations, manufacturing operations and the Kazakhstan reinvestment portfolio.

Prior to this position, Frank was the West Area Operations Manager for the Gulf of Mexico business unit, responsible for shelf operations from Louisiana to Texas. Frank started his career with Chevron on the finance MBA program and has progressed through technical and leadership roles of increasing responsibility in finance, commercial, project management, and operations management positions in the United States and Thailand.
